Dr. Bae received a bachelor's degree in biology from Carleton University in 2006. After graduation he returned to South Korea to serve two years of military service (2006-2008) as Korean Augmentation to the United States Army. He earned his master's degree in Environment Management, with specialization in invasive plant ecology, at Seoul National University in 2010, where he investigated the impact of the ongoing climate change on allelopathy of invasive plant

species. He continued his research journey at McGill University and the AAFC Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu Research and Development Centre, where he led a research project on integrated roadside weed management in southern Québec, and completed a Ph.D. in plant science in 2014. In December 2014, Dr. Bae joined the Weed Science and Ecology programs at the AAFC Harrow Research and Development Centre as a NSERC postdoctoral fellow, where he participated in several research projects on ecology and management of herbicide-resistant weeds. In July 2017, Dr. Jichul Bae joined the Agassiz Research and Development Centre as a research scientist in Horticultural Crop Management Specialist – Weeds.
